# Publication of the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan - Proposed Submission

The VALP Proposed Submission document is due to start a six-week public consultation period from 9am Thursday 2 November until 5.15pm Thursday 14 December 2017.

On 18 October the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan (VALP) Proposed Subm ission document was approved by Council for consultation and subsequent submission to the Secretary of State.

The VALP Proposed Submission has been published in order for representations to be made which specifically relate to the legal compliance and soundness of the Plan before it is submitted for an independent examination. This period is fixed by legislation and there is no room for flexibility.

Passwords must be a minimum of four characters; these can include numbers if you wish. Once you have done this, please make a note of your password as you will require this to access the system once you wish to submit your representations.

All consultees must ensure that personal details are completed in full. Failure to do so will result in your representation not being accepted, as this is a legal requirement.

Following the period for comment, we will summarise and collate the responses for the Planning Inspector. We will then submit the VALP Strategy (alongside the comments) to the Planning Inspector for independent examination .
