In June 2015 all households were issued with the Community led plan brochure having been completed by the Steering Committee consisting of Carol Robson, Mark Tasker, John Hopcroft, Matt Grierson, Nick Hughes, Grace Blackwell, Jo Botha, Ramsay Hovell, Laura Merry, David Small and David McBain who had the final document printed.

A litter pick was organised by the Clerk and lots of helpful residents turned out to help followed by a drink at the Clifden Arms. Thanks to those volunteers.

4 Self Closing gates were fitted on the public footpaths with funding provided by the Local Area Forum.

A letter drafted by Dr Helen Weaver who was the Chairman at the time to ask for the reinstatement of the bus stop in Waterperry Road.

Councillor Weaver unfortunately tendered her resignation due to work commitments but volunteered to carry on checking the defibrillator annually. I would like to take the opportunity to thank her for her work as Chairperson.

The broken streetlight in the Avenue has been replaced with funds supplied kindly by Mr Peter Hawes. Thank you.

The defibrillator now has a new home and will be available for all residents at the Village Hall. Thanks for donations from the Social Committee and Camo Skips.

Cllr Steven Bramley came onto the Council in January this year and is eager to start work on the Neighbourhood Plan with support from Cllr Skates and 3 members of the public.

Lastly I would like to give a big thanks to Mark Tasker who will be leaving us and a special thanks to Adele our Parish Clerk for her sterling work over the past year.

Time Out is still operating and Robin Wallhouse gave thanks to his cyclists and loyal residents for giving so generously enabling them to donate £1000 to the Village Hall.
