

## **WORMINGHALL COMMUNITY CONTINGENCY PLAN**

### **1. Identify nature of Accident and notify service/s required.**

**Dial 999 for Police/Fire/Ambulance – Anti Terrorism should go via police.**

Be prepared to give:

- Name, telephone number and location/address
- Full details of the incident (as far as can be ascertained without incurring risk) including time and location and current assessment of situation.
- What emergency services are being requested.
- Estimation of number of casualties, human/animal including injuries sustained and/or fatalities.
- Warn of any perceived hazard ie road block/ fire /flood etc.
