In the event of a major incident which may threaten the safety and welfare of the community, the Community Response Team co-ordinates the community's responses to the emergency, especially in extreme circumstances when the emergency services are delayed in reaching the parish area. Community response ensures that vulnerable people are cared for and self help to householders is promoted. Where a parish has an emergency plan the Community Response Team are responsible for keeping the plan up to date.

Please bear in mind that plans should be simple, and only serve to record information and plans which are useful for your area.

If the emergency services need to contact a member of your organisation in an emergency, which number(s) could they call? It is important to include at least two. One of the contacts should be available at any point, 24 hours a day. (i.e. one person may be a daytime contact, and another cover evenings).
